We are conscious that the way in which buildings and facilities are designed has a particular impact on disabled people, elderly people and parents with children. Whilst recognising the need to maintain the aesthetic and architectural elements of these premises, we aim to ensure their access requirements are fully considered and incorporated in any proposals or events.

We want these buildings and facilities to be fully accessible to all visitors and regular users, and have made every effort to comply with all relevant legislation and best practice, particularly the Disability Discrimination Act 1995.

Entrances and corridors...



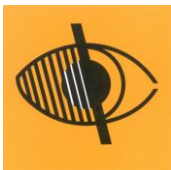
- ✓ All entrances and corridors are well lit and kept clear of obstructions.
- ✓ All doorways are of the required width, and wherever possible have level thresholds
- ✓ Access ramps of suitable gradient are available to our main entrances.
- ✓ Full accessibility is possible throughout the premises.
- ✗ We are unable to provide fully accessible access to our first floor meeting room

For the hearing impaired...



- ✓ Our main worship hall is equipped with a full spatial sound system and an induction loop system
- ✓ We have a portable sound system together with induction loop system for use in our main community hall and meeting rooms

For the visually impaired...



- ✓ The majority of resources used in our worship are clearly displayed in large text format on a projection screen
- ✓ Large text formats of bibles and song books are available
- ✓ All of our signs and notices comply with relevant legislation

Disabled parking or setting down...



- ✗ Unfortunately we do not have designated parking areas. Setting down is permitted immediately adjacent to our main entrance.
- ✓ Bus stops are situated immediately adjacent to and opposite our premises
- ✓ A wheelchair is available for use whilst on the premises

WC and hygiene facilities...



- ✓ Adequate facilities are available, including a fully equipped facility with ready access and call system
